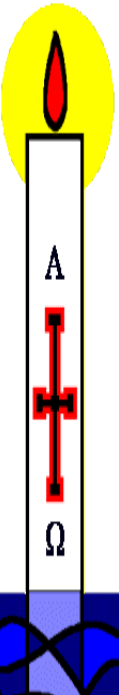
We invite you to be with us as we celebrate Holy Week here in our Parish of Our Lady of the Wayside Bluebell.
