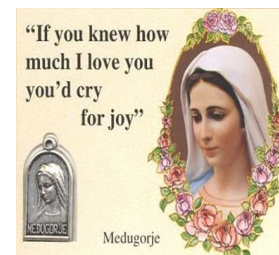
Golden Jubilee Celebrations:
